Charlotte Griffin Ahalt, age 82, passed away Christmas Day December 25, 2025 at home surrounded by her family. Born in Rocky Mount, NC on December 9, 1943 to the late Richard Taswell Griffin and Fidelia Overton. She was the youngest of ten siblings raised on her family's dairy farm.

Charlotte is survived by her husband of 55 years, Thomas Ahalt and her two children Ashley Ahalt Drenning (husband Bowen) and Brian Thomas Ahalt (wife Polly); five grandchildren, Ty Benjamin Drenning, Seth Griffin Drenning, Wynn Ashley Drenning, Laurel Daly Wedemeyer, and

Charlotte Daly Ahalt. She is also survived by three sisters, and two sisters-in-law. 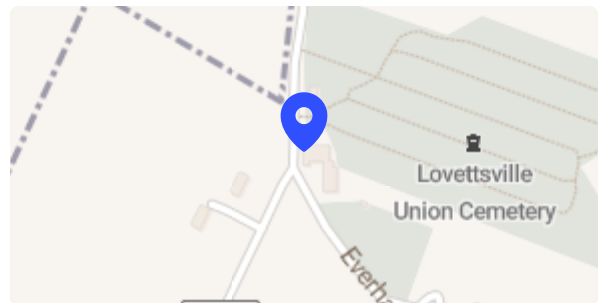
