Sandra Rodriguez Pancoast passed away peacefully on January 18, 2026, in Leesburg, VA, following a courageous battle with cancer.

Sandra was born in Puerto Rico to Victor and Consuelo Rodriguez. In 1975, she married R. Bruce Pancoast in New Jersey. Together, they celebrated 50 years of devoted marriage in 2025.

Sandra was an Office Manager for Lansdowne Orthodontics for 14 years until her retirement. A dedicated Jehovah's Witness for over six decades, she remained committed to the Christian ministry throughout her life. A natural caregiver and gifted writer, Sandra was often sought out for her sage advice and her ability to touch hearts through the written word. 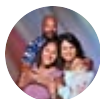
