She attended Brigham Young University, earning a degree in Communications. 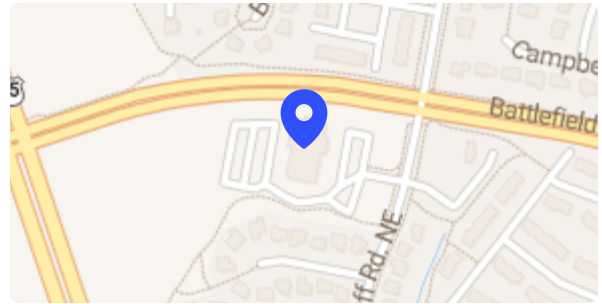

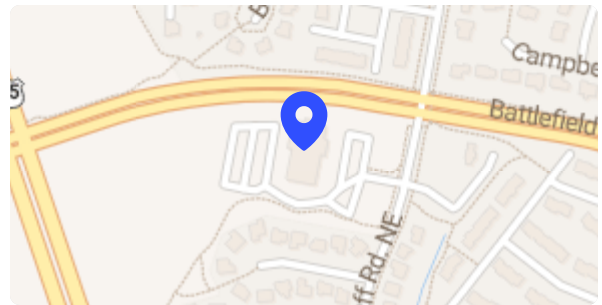
