## **William Robert "Bob" Hoskinson**

**W**ILLIAM ROBERT (BOB) HOSKINSON, 64, of Leesburg, Virginia passed away after a long battle with cancer. Mr. Hoskinson was born September 13, 1948 in East Liverpool, OH to the late William F. and Betty Hoskinson. He received his BS in Electrical Engineering from the University of Buffalo and his MBA from Canisius College, Buffalo, NY. He was a Principle Engineer with MC Dean in Dulles, VA.

Mr. Hoskinson received an Eagle Scout badge while a student at Scotia-Glenville High School. He continued to support scouting as his son's scout leader with Troop #57 in Gladstone, NJ. He was active in youth soccer in Ridgefield, CT as a coach, referee and club officer. He was also a Fourth Degree Knight of the Knights of Columbus Holy Family Council 6831 at St. John the Apostle Catholic Church in Leesburg. He loved skiing, sailing, gardening, traveling, doing puzzles, and spending time with family and friends.

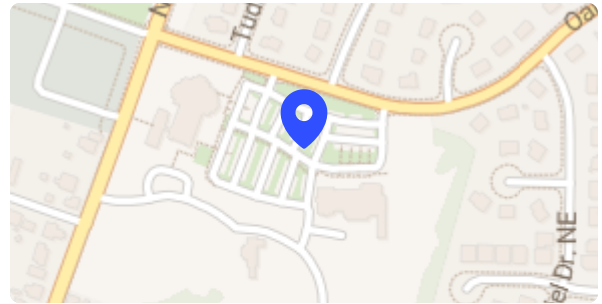

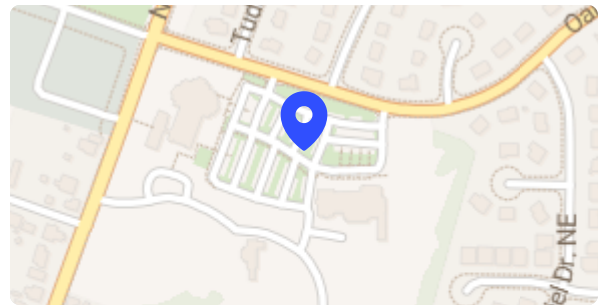

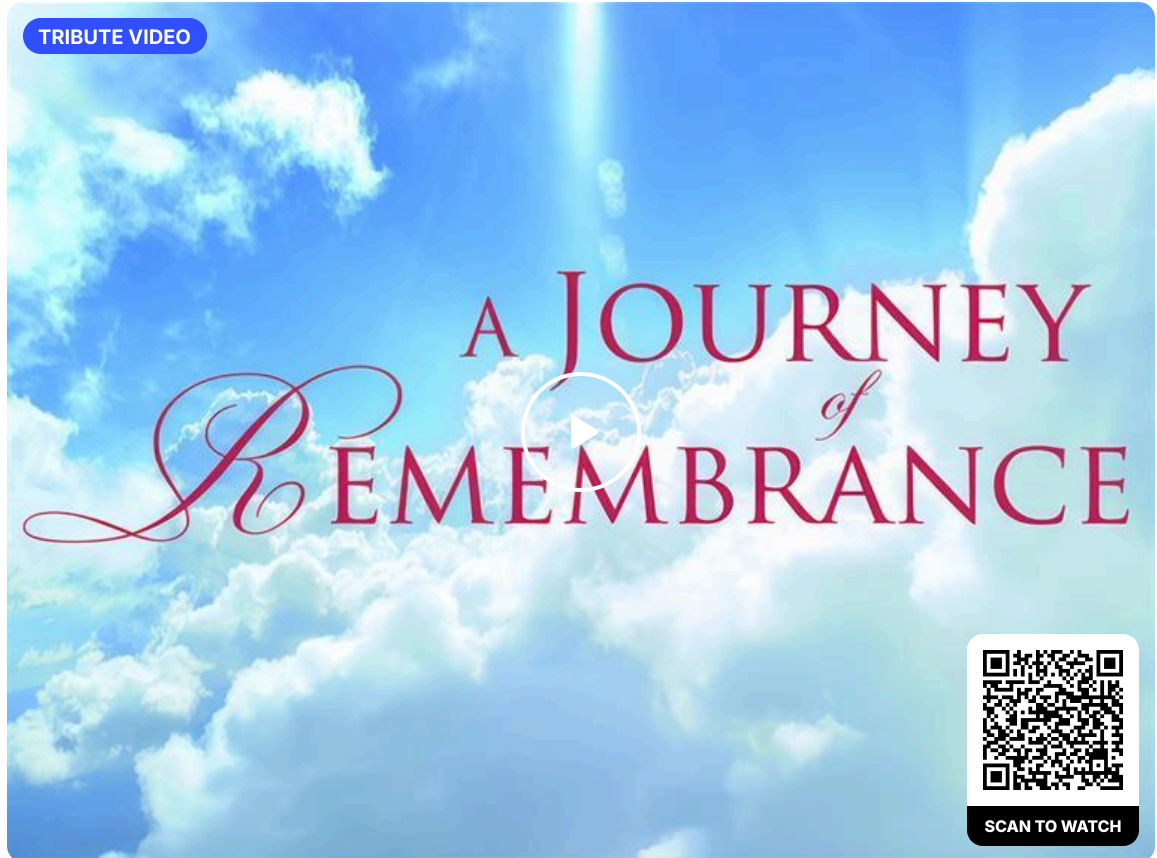
