John W. Young, age 54, of Leesburg, VA, passed away on Monday, August 26, 2019, at Capital Caring, Adler Center in Aldie, VA after a long battle with pancreatic neuroendocrine cancer.

Born Friday, September 4, 1964 in Hartford, Connecticut, he was the son of the late John R. Young and Diana Ramsdell. He was the nephew of Norman and the late Evelyn Young whom considered him to be their heart, soul, and treasure.

He is survived by his wife of 26 years, Elizabeth A.
